Materials and Measurements

Finished size approx	25 x 25	cm
	10 x 10	ins
One Four Legged Friends Scarf Kit. 2 - 4mm (UK8- US6) Knitting needles. Stitch holder.		

IMPORTANT

Use only the Wendy yarn specified. We cannot accept responsibility for an imperfect garment if any other brand is used. It is essential to work to the tension stated. The quantities of yarn stated are based on average requirements and are therefore approximate.

ABBREVIATIONS

K - Knit; **P** - Purl; **st(s)** - stitch(es); **st st** - stocking stitch (1 row K, 1 row P); **rept** - repeat; **yfwd** - yarn forward; **tog** - together; **cm** - centimetres; **ins** - inches.

TENSION

It is important to check your tension before commencing the item. 22 sts and 31 rows to 10cm, 4ins over st st on 4mm needles. If there are too many stitches to 10cm, then your tension is tight and you will need to change your needle to a larger size. If there are too few stitches to 10cm, then your tension is loose and you will need to change your needle to a smaller size.

BASE

Using 4mm needles, cast on 24 sts. Work in st st for 23cm, 9ins, ending with a P row, and placing markers at each end of

the row when work measures 11.5cm, 4½ins. Cast off.

BAG

Using 4mm needles, cast on 115 sts.

Place marker after 57 sts.

Commencing with a K row, work in st st for 18cm, 7ins, ending with a P row.

Next row – K1, * P1, K1, rept from * to end.

Next row – P1, * K1, P1, rept from * to end.

These 2 rows form rib, repeat these 2 rows 3 times more.

Next row (make eyelets) – K1, * [P1, K1] four times, yfwd, K2tog, rept from * to last 4 sts, [P1, K1] twice.

Next row – P1, * K1, P1, rept from * to end.

Continue in rib for 4 more rows.

Commence Flap

Next row - P2tog and place a marker on this st, rib 14 sts, then place 15 sts just worked onto a st holder, cast off next 83 sts, rib to end then, starting at marked st and keeping rib correct, rib across sts left on holder. 31 sts.

These 31 sts form the flap, keeping rib correct as set, work on these 31 sts until Flap measures 8.5cm, 3¼ins.

Cast off in rib.

Straps (make 2)

Using 4mm needles, cast on 7 sts.

1st row – K1, * P1, K1, rept from * to end.

2nd row – P1, * K1, P1, rept from * to end.

These 2 rows form rib, repeat these 2 rows until strap measures 30cm, 12ins or desired length to fit.

Cast off.

MAKING UP

Join back seam of bag by top sewing. Join base to the bottom of the bag, making sure that the centre front markers are aligned and that the back seam is aligned with the other marker.

Make a twisted cord to thread through eyelet holes.

Attach straps to rear of bag at top and bottom, adjusting for a good fit. Sew animal face, legs and tail to flap and front of bag as shown in photograph.
